Uniform Requirement

All students ages **2 to 4 years** are required to wear uniforms daily, unless otherwise stated by the administration.

Uniforms can be purchased anywhere school uniforms are sold. However, all shirts, sweaters, and jackets must have the school's logo embroidered.

Please do not alter, decorate, or substitute any part of the official uniform.

Footwear and Accessories

To maintain safety and minimize injury risk:

- **Prohibited footwear** includes:
 - o Open-toed sandals
 - o Flip-flops
 - o Open-toe shoes
 - Any style of boots
- Permitted footwear:
 - Closed-toe shoes suitable for outdoor play
 - o All black shoes with protected tie laces

Jewelry Guidelines:

- Not allowed: Dangling earrings, bracelets, necklaces (due to safety and choking hazards)
- Girls: Hair beads are not permitted
- Boys: Hair shells are not permitted

If your child arrives wearing beads, they must be removed by the following school day. Failure to do so will result in your child being denied entry to the building.

Uniform Guidelines & Required Items

General Daily Uniform:

- IILC-branded T-shirts or polos
- Solid-colored pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers in black, navy, or khaki
- Monogrammed sweaters or jackets (for classroom wear)

Girls:

- Navy or khaki skirts

- Girls' Anti-Pill Cardigan Sweater School Uniforms | French Toast French
 Toast (navy)
- All black shoes (protected tie laces)

Girls' Chapel Attire (Wednesdays):

- <u>Girls Plaid Jumper School Uniforms by French Toast French Toast</u> (Blue Gold plaid)
- White Peter Pan collar blouse (with plaid cross adjustable tie)

Boys:

- Navy or white pique polo shirt
- Navy or khaki relaxed fit twill pants or shorts
- Classic dress shirt (with plaid adjustable tie)
- Anti-pill V-neck cardigan sweater
- All black shoes (protected tie laces)

Boys' Chapel Attire (Wednesdays):

- Classic dress shirt (with plaid adjustable necktie <u>Boys' Adjustable Plaid Tie School</u> <u>Uniforms | French Toast - French Toast</u>
- Navy blue relaxed fit pants

Christian Environment Dress Code

Please remember that IILC is a Christian learning environment. **Clothing featuring the following is not permitted**:

- Obscene images or words
- Skulls, witches, or weapons

Additional Notes

- **Label all clothing** with your child's name to prevent loss.
- Each child must have a **complete change of uniform** stored at the center in a labeled container.
- **Extra shirts used as backup** do **not** need to be monogrammed.
- An **extra sweater or lightweight jacket** is recommended due to varying classroom temperatures.
- If your child uses their backup clothing, please **replace it the next day**.

Potty Training Guidance

For potty-training children:

- Dress them in **easy-to-manage separates** (no onesies, overalls, or belts)
- Re-attachable pull-ups are preferred
- This supports independence and reduces frustration

Outdoor Play Requirements

Weather permitting, all children are required to spend **1 to 1.5 hours outdoors daily**, per state regulations.

- Please send weather-appropriate outerwear
- If your child must stay indoors for medical reasons, a **doctor's note** is required
- Outdoor restriction is limited to **3 consecutive days** (Georgia Code #591-1-1-.03)

Shoes must be safe for running and outdoor activities. **No boots, sandals, flip-flops, crocs, dress shoes, open-toed or open-backed shoes are permitted.**

Non-Compliance

Failure to follow the uniform policy may result in a call home to request a change of clothing. Consistent non-compliance may lead to further action.
